## Costs

- Tuition/fees: **£4,000** (\$5,100 as of 7/11/24)
- Meals, transportation, personal expenses: **\$4,000/semester** (Varies)
- Study abroad/exchange fee: **\$400/semester**
- Housing: Approximately **£150 per week** (\$200 per week)
- GeoBlue insurance: **\$13/week**
- Airfare: **\$1,200 (varies)**
- WUE/GEM/Treasure eligible: **No**
- Boise State employee dependent fee waiver: **No**
- **Broncos Abroad** pricing is a Boise State negotiated fee with the host university. It usually will be a lower cost than many program providers. You will pay the university directly for the costs. All costs subject to change

## Academic Calendar

The QMU calendar is a good fit for American students as the fall semester starts with orientation in mid-September. Classes begin in the third week, finishing in mid-December. The spring semester starts around the second week of January with teaching beginning a week later, finishing at the end of April.
