

Student Dress Code Template

It is suggested you include a Student Dress Code in your orientation. This can also be found in the Student Orientation Handbook Template. Feel free to use or edit the language below as needed for your agency.

You are required to present yourself in a neat, clean, well-groomed manner, and avoid dressing in a way that will reflect negatively on [insert agency name], as well as Boise State University. If you are unsure of what is considered appropriate dress, please ask your supervisor to clarify for you. Your supervisor reserves the right to determine if your clothing is inappropriate for the service setting.

Items to avoid wearing to serve include:

- tops with obscene, sexually suggestive, profane graphics and/or messages
- revealing clothing, halter / spaghetti / tank tops, see-through or provocative clothing, exposed undergarments or exposed inappropriate body parts, clothing that is so tight as to be a distraction to other employees or clients.
- any clothing with inappropriate tears, rips, slits, or stains
- hats, caps, and other head gear
- pants, shorts, or skirts with messages written on the rear end

The agency will not be held responsible for jewelry, clothing, shoes, etc., damaged during working hours if the clothing does not meet the guidelines of this policy.
